## Installation

### How to install the Template

In order to proceed with the theme installation, you need to make sure you have the latest version of WordPress on your self-hosted site.

To install this theme you must have a working version of WordPress already installed. For information on installing the WordPress platform, please see the WordPress Codex. Upon downloading the .zip file from Themeforest, you'll have all files you need inside. Extract the .zip file and inside you will find the theme zip file called "plexx.zip", that is the file you need to install.

#### Follow the steps below to install theme:

1. Navigate to **Appearance > Themes**.
2. Click **Add New** then **Upload Theme**.
3. Click **Choose File** and Navigate to find the **manggis.zip** file on your computer and click **Install Now** button. The theme will be uploaded and installed.
4. Activate the newly installed theme. Go to **Appearance > Themes** and **Activate** the installed theme.

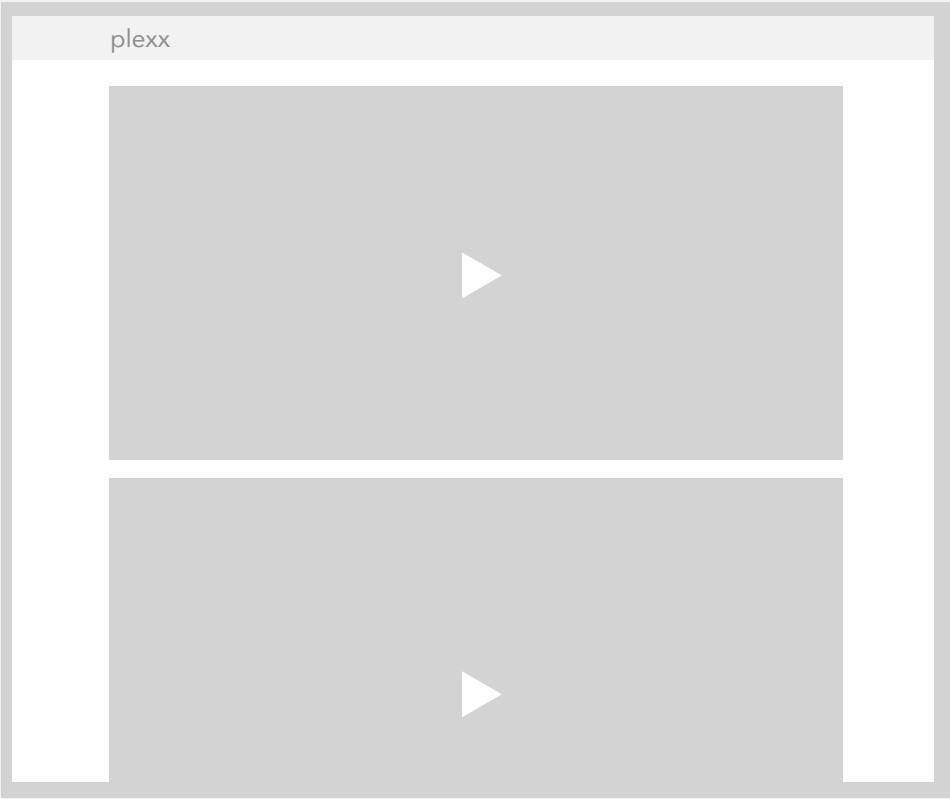

- 5. **Hide Hover Info** — hide project information on mouse hover.
- 6. **Show Fullsize Image** — if you using animated GIF as featured image you can activate this option.
- 7. **Custom URL** — type URL here if you want redirect by clicking.
- 8. **Packery Size** — image size for Packery portfolio template.

### Header:

- 1. **Hide Page Title** — you can hide Title for this Portfolio Project.
- 2. **Custom Title** — custom title if you want to change it but want to keep Page Title.
- 3. **Subtitle** — short text for subtitle.
- 4. **Title Text Align** — aligning for Title and Subtitle: Left, Center and Right.

- 6. Hover Layer Opacity** — opacity for mouse hover layer in percents, default is 100%.
- 7. Disable Hover Layer** — you can turn off all hover layers in current project.
- 8. Logo** — color for current portfolio portfolio logo.
- 9. Menu** — menu color.

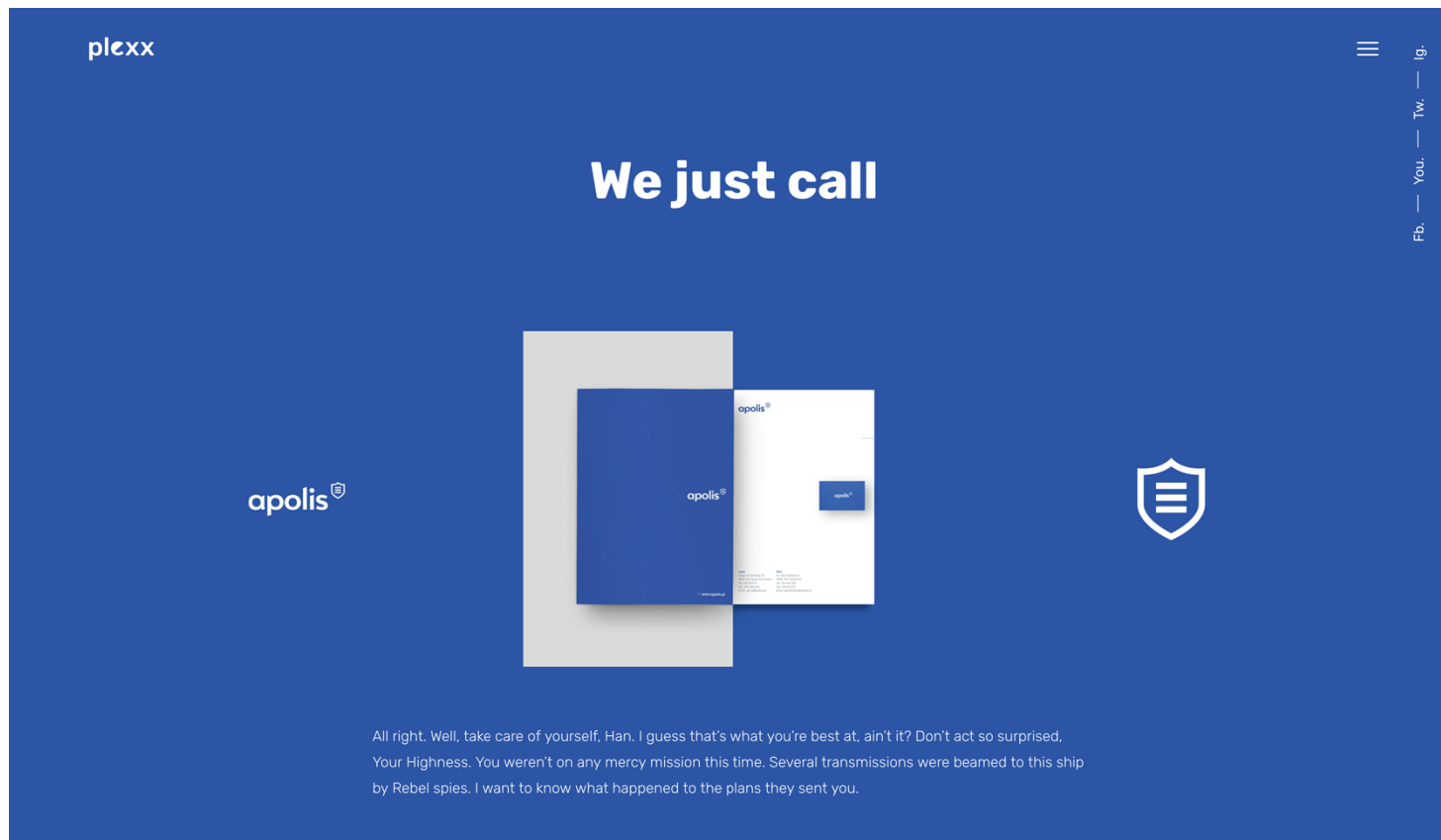

4. Assign **Featured Image** which will show as Post Thumbnail on Blog Page.
5. Choose **Categories** or add new.
